## Information on the processing of personal data (GDPR) - FACEBOOK.

Our activities comply with the requirements contained in Facebook regulations and PROSTER sp. z o.o. administers your personal data in order to answer questions, comment on posts, communicate with other users and in connection with information posted by us (for the purposes of promoting our activities and marketing activities).
- 3. We collect and process the following types of personal data: Facebook ID, profile picture, other pictures, content of comments and content of the conversation carried out by the communication application.
- 4. The processing of personal data is carried out on the following legal bases:
  - a. consent -Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR when you send us inquiries;
  - b. agreement Article 6(1)(b) of the GDPR in the event of your intention to use the services we provide in connection with your business;
  - c. legitimate interest of the controller Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR in the case of the implementation of promotional activities.
- 5. The information we hold in your messages will be kept for as long as we respond to you or until the relationship ends. In the case of comments, they will be available on our website until their author deletes them. Your personal data collected by Facebook are stored on the terms set out in separate Facebook regulations.
- 6. You have the following rights under the terms of the GDPR: the right of access to your data, the right to obtain a copy of your data (if there will be an opportunity to do so), the right to rectification, the right to erasure, the right to restrict processing, the right to object to processing, the right to portability (if there will be an opportunity to do so), the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Data Protection Authority.
